

# Kiwanis Basketball Rules and Guidelines

11/25/2008

Uses the Ohio High School Rules and Regulation with the following exception:

- 1) a) Grades 9th through 12th have 15 minute halves.  
b) Grades 7th and 8th have 7 minute Quarters.
  
- 2) One overtime for 3 minutes is played for tie games. If still tied than:  
Sudden death -first one to Score a point.  
Exceptions are tournament games
  
- 3) All teams must have 5 players to start the game. Forfeit is the result after  
a 5 minute waiting period. Games can be completed with less than 5 players.
  
- 4) Swearing and/or abusive behavior will result in a technical foul and possibly  
expulsion. (Referee  
discretion).
  - 4a) Any expulsion will result in a one game minimum suspension.
  - 4b) Any expulsion due to a violent foul (referee, commissioner's judgement) will  
result in a minimum two games to a maximum suspension for the remainder of the season.
  - 4c) A written apology will be necessary for re-instatement
  - 4d) Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players and fans.  
If you can not do this you will be  
replaced.
  
- 5) Fighting will result in participants being ejected from the league
  
- 6) No food or drinks are allowed in the GYM
  
- 7) Time outs = one the first half and 2 the second half. No carryovers.  
One  
additional timeout in overtime.
  
- 8) One and one is awarded on the seventh team foul.
  
- 9) Two shot fouls are awarded on the 10 th team foul.
  
- 10) 20 point Rule--If one team is 20 points ahead, then the clock will not stop , except  
for foul shots and time-outs. The time will resume as normal if the score returns to  
less than a 20 point difference.
  
- 11) No bracelets, ear rings or necklaces are to be worn on the court during games.
  
- 12) All players must be paid and be on the official list or games could be forfeited.
  
- 13) No one assigns players to teams except George Beller or  
Will Walker for the High School

Luke Jones/Mike Maynard for 9th &10th grades  
Mike Wesselman/Charles Isley for the 7th & 8th grades.

14) School regulations:

When FHSD closes schools, our games and practices are also cancelled.

Access to building limited to gym and nearby restrooms

Adult (coaches) supervision is required at all games and practices

Custodians have total authority. Do what they tell you!

Only Commissioners can authorize gym time. Do not call schools.

Give back any unused gym time. Everything cost money.
